



# Nanjing Agricultural University

## Introduction

---

- Founded in 1902, Nanjing Agricultural University (NAU) has a history of more than 120 years. It is a pioneer of modern higher agricultural education, research and extension, and the first institution in China to offer four-year bachelor's programs in agricultural disciplines.
- NAU is a multi-disciplinary national key university under the administration of the Chinese Ministry of Education. With agriculture and life sciences as its dominant field, NAU has diverse branches of learning in its 20 colleges, such as sciences, economics, management, engineering, law and arts.
- NAU now consists of five faculties: Plant Sciences, Animal Sciences, Biology and Environment, Food and Engineering, and Social Sciences. NAU offers 65 Bachelor's programs, 96 Master's programs, and 53 Doctoral programs. Currently we have over 17,000 undergraduate students and about 11,700 graduate students studying at the university. There are more than 2,900 faculty and staff members. Since 2017, the number of international students for both degree and non-degree programs has surpassed 1,000.

- One of the institutions of higher education with Double First-class Disciplines under China's Double First-class University Project.

- Seven academic disciplines offered at NAU were graded in the A category (A<sup>+</sup>: Crop Science, Agricultural Resources and Environment, Plant Protection, Agricultural and Forestry Economics and Management; A: Public Administration; A<sup>-</sup>: Food Science and Engineering, Horticulture) according to the results of the 4th round of China's national assessment of First-level Disciplines announced by the Ministry of Education in December 2017. With four A<sup>+</sup> disciplines, NAU ranks No.11 among Chinese universities nationwide.
- Ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in zero hunger (SDG 2) according to THE Impact Rankings 2020 by SDG.
- Ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the latest ranking of "Best Global Universities for Agricultural Sciences" by US News & World Report in 2023.
- Ranks 37<sup>th</sup> in Agriculture & Forestry according to the 2023 QS World University Rankings by Subject.
- Ten disciplines—Agricultural Science, Plant & Animal Sciences, Environmental Science and Ecology, Biology and Biochemistry, Engineering, Microbiology, Molecular Biology and Genetics, Chemistry, Pharmacology and Toxicology, Social Science General — are among the world's 1% according to Essential Science Indicators (ESI) rankings. In particular, Agricultural Sciences and Plant & Animal Sciences are among the world's top 1‰, placing NAU at the global forefront in these fields.

## 1. Application Eligibility

- Degree Programs

<b>Bachelor's Programs</b>	Certificate of high school diploma; Good academic performance; Good health; Under age 25.
<b>Master's Programs</b>	Certificate of a bachelor degree with a related major; Good academic performance; Good health; Under age 35.
<b>Doctoral Programs</b>	Certificate of a master degree with a related major; Good academic performance; Good health; Under age 40.

- Non-degree Programs

<b>General Scholar Programs</b>	Certificate of an advanced diploma/equivalent; Under age 45.
<b>Senior Scholar Programs</b>	Certificate of a master degree/an associate professorship; Under age 50.

## 2. Language Requirement

<b>Chinese Language</b>	HSK Level 5 is mandatory for <b>bachelor's program</b> applicants and Chinese-taught Graduate Programs.
<b>English Language</b>	From English-speaking country (or); With 1 year or above discipline-relevant experience in English-speaking countries (or); Certificate of IELTS $\geq 6$ or TOFEL $\geq 80$ (TOFEL Mybest Scores is accepted, university DI code:C702, TOFEL Essentials are accepted.)

<b>No.5 Notarized Academic Transcripts of Highest Education Achieved</b>	In Chinese / English; Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
<b>No.6 Constructive Study/ Research Plan</b>	In Chinese / English; This should be a minimum of 800 words.
<b>No.7 Two Recommendation Letters</b>	Mandatory for postgraduate degree/non-degree program applicants; In Chinese / English; Must be written by professors/associate professors.
<b>No.8 Acceptance Letter from a NAU Supervisor</b>	Mandatory for postgraduate degree/non-degree program applicants; The acceptance letter must be signed and approved by the master/doctoral supervisor of the discipline, otherwise it will be invalid.
<b>No.9 Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form</b>	Can only be issued and printed by the Chinese Quarantine Authority; In Chinese / English; Strictly complete the entire examination with proper signature from medical professionals; The result of the medical examination has a time limit of 6 months. Please arrange the examination time accordingly.
<b>No.10 The Copy of Valid HSK/English Certificate</b>	
<b>No.11 Non-criminal Record Report</b>	If the applicant is unable to provide this document, the applicant can inform the applied university and sign a non-criminal record commitment instead.
<b>No.12 Copy of Valid Passport and Relevant Residence Documents</b>	Copy of valid passport. Undergraduate program applicant whose either or both parents are Chinese citizens and have settled in a foreign country must provide a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for 4 years (or above), and provide records of actual residence in a foreign country for more than 2 years within the last 4 years (by April 30 of the enrolment year). (The actual residence in a foreign country for 9 months can be calculated as one year, subject to the entry and exit records).
<b>No.13 Others</b>	Passport size personal ID photo Publication (no need to submit for the fourth author and

above);

**Step 4.** Register and apply in the NAU university application system <https://njau.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>.

**Step 5.** Pay the application fee: CNY 500 or USD 80. While transferring application fee to NAU's bank account, please indicate your name and passport number on bank note's remark area and send the receipt to [admission@njau.edu.cn](mailto:admission@njau.edu.cn). The application fee is NON-REFUNDABLE once remitted.
