



Undergraduate Program of Chinese Medicine Major (5 Years)

1. Orientation

This program will enable students to maintain upstanding value orientation of Chinese medicine, understand its essential theory, grasp its expertise and practical skills and improve their self-learning ability.

3. Teaching Methods

These include classroom lectures, group discussions, bedside teaching, simulated demonstration, practical training, social practice and problem-based learning (PBL). The teaching will highlight the training on students' self-learning ability. Most lectures will take place in the Zhangjiang Campus, most clinical internship and probation will take place in the affiliated hospitals.

4. Graduation and Academic Degree

A Bachelor of Medical Science will be awarded upon completion of

- Required credits all courses in the teaching scheme
- General points average (GPA)
- Pass of all examinations
- New HSK-5 \geq 180 (excluding those of Chinese origin)

5. Future Career Development

After graduation, students may conduct medical practice in Chinese internal medicine, external medicine, gynecology, pediatrics and traumatology. They may also work in the fields of prevention, healthcare and rehabilitation. Alternatively, they may conduct Chinese medical education, research, and management in medical institutions.

6. Eligibilities

- High school diploma, General Certificate of Education Advanced Level



- New HSK4 \geq 180
- Applicants emigrating from mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao or Taiwan must hold a valid foreign citizenship for no less than 4 years and a record of residency in the country for no less than 2 years in the most recent 4 years.

- Application fee: 450 RMB
- Tuition fee: 28000RMB per year
- Purchase fee for textbooks
(Students can purchase textbooks according to their needs)
