



Program of Chinese Language (Traditional Chinese Medicine-oriented) Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SHUTCM)

Academic Year & Curriculum

This is a 4-year program, 3 trimesters per academic year.

Curriculum (160 Credits)

Program Orientation

The program aims to cultivating talents who are qualified to conduct TCM international cooperation, TCM international dissemination, and international trade in TCM with a grasp of TCM basics and proficient Chinese language communication and translation skills.

Graduation and Academic Degree

A Bachelor of Arts will be awarded upon completion of

- Required credits of all courses in the teaching scheme (Attachment 1)
- Pass of all examinations
- New HSK 6 \geq 180

Eligibilities

- High school graduation or above; certified transcripts of A-Level course, IB or AP
- New HSK 3 \geq 180 (for non-Chinese ethnics) or pass the entrance examination of Chinese in SHUTCM
- Applicants emigrating from mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao or Taiwan must hold a valid foreign citizenship for no less than 4 years and a record of residency in the country for no less than 2 years in the most recent 4 years (Before April 30, 2023). (Actual residency for 9 months can be counted as one year based on entry and exit stamps)
- 16-65 years old

Fees

- 450 RMB for application (The actual amount university receives)



- 20,000 RMB/year for tuition
- Purchase fee for textbooks
- Accommodation Fee
- Live on campus: Please see Introduction of International Student's Dormitory (Attachment 2). Notice of the accommodation arrangement will be sent out in middle July. (The accommodation fee may fluctuate).
- Live off-campus: Students can live off-campus upon approval by the University and pay on themselves.

Application Documents

- Scan of the passport (valid for 6 months after date of submission)
- High school diploma or above and/or A-Level/IB/AP course transcripts
- HSK certificate (for non-Chinese ethnics)
- Certificate of Non-Criminal Record (Or sign a commitment with SHUTCM, Attachment 7)
- Statement of Financial Support (Or provide bank statement which can cover all fees needed in China; or ownership certificate of chattels and realties; or sign a commitment with SHUTCM, Attachment 8)
- Invoice of the application fee
- Student ID Photo:
 - Rename: Chinese name, JPG file
 - Requirement: Blue or white background, Bareheaded, 3.5*5.4cm, 626*413px resolution, 100-500k
